1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Duel Waterline competition is organized as part of the Outdoormix Festival from Friday, May 22nd to Monday, May 25th, 2026. This event is organized by the non-profit association WeAreHautesAlpes, represented by Mr. Brice Clovis, President.

The purpose of these regulations is to ensure your safety and well-being. We encourage you to follow these regulations and the recommendations below.

Check-in and registration close 1 hour before each competition.

2. COMPETITION

The “DUEL WATERLINE” competition will take place on Saturday, May 23rd and Sunday, May 24th, 2026 at the Outdoormix Festival village. Competitors will face off in a speed duel on two lines of equal length. The competition consists of two rounds: the qualifying rounds and the final. During the qualifying rounds, competitors must complete a 30-meter run side-by-side on two separate slacklines in the shortest possible time. The winner of each duel is the first to reach the end of the run. If there is a fall, the winner is the competitor who travels the furthest on the slackline.

At the end of each qualifying duel, the winners will advance to the next round. The qualifying rounds end when only 8 participants remain, who will advance to the final.

The same speed duel format will be used in the final.

2.1. Program

3. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

The Waterline Duel is open to all competitors aged 16 and over.

Registration for the Waterline Duel is individual, non-transferable, and non-refundable. No refunds, full or partial, will be issued by the organizers.

To participate, each competitor must register at the event's welcome desk and be equipped with the required gear. Minors are required to provide parental authorization for the Waterline Duel.



Wearing a neck gaiter or earplugs is recommended to reduce the risk of eardrum perforation from a fall onto the water.

4. ACCESS TO FACILITIES

All users must be registered to participate in the competition.

All users are required to respect the facilities, other users, and the organization's staff.

It is **STRICTLY** forbidden for two or more people to use a slackline/waterline together.

Each user is responsible for themselves and must know their own skill level.

Minors must show parental authorization each time they use a slackline/waterline.

Users are advised not to leave their personal belongings unattended. The organization cannot be held responsible for the loss of personal items due to user negligence.

The organization cannot be held responsible for any damages resulting from the misuse of the equipment provided.

Any damage to the equipment may result in the perpetrator being held liable.

Any failure to comply with these rules may lead to the revocation of authorization to use the equipment.

Any person who, through their behavior, disturbs public order, disrupts the organization of various activities, undermines morality, hygiene, and safety, may be immediately expelled from the structure by the organizer and/or the competent authority.

5. INSURANCE & LIABILITY

The organization has taken out insurance covering its own civil liability as organizer, that of its employees, and that of volunteers assisting with the event. Personal accident insurance is also in place to cover bodily injury each participant may sustain, as well as any accidents caused to third parties.

Medical and hospitalization expenses remain the responsibility of the participants (personal insurance). The organization accepts no responsibility for the loss, theft, or damage of personal belongings or equipment and cannot be held liable under any circumstances. No refunds will be issued for participants who withdraw from the race.

6. RESULTS & PODIUMS

À l'issue de l'épreuve, un podium récompensera les trois premiers de l'épreuve. Les différents classements établis en fonction des genres et âges des compétiteurs seront affichés en face de l'accueil du village événement. Des récompenses (lots) seront attribuées aux trois premiers



sportifs d'après le classement général.

At the end of the event, a podium ceremony will reward the best athletes. The result sheets, established according to the competitors' genders and ages, will be displayed in front of the event village reception desk. Prizes will be awarded to the top three athletes in the overall ranking.

For all categories, a podium will be set up once five participants are registered and present. The organizer reserves the right to distribute the prizes as they see fit. The presence of winning competitors at the awards ceremony is mandatory. Prizes cannot be given to a third party and will not be mailed.

7. CANCELLATION AND COMMITMENT

The organizers reserve the right to modify these regulations at any time to ensure the safety and well-being of participants. In the event of *force majeure*, the organizers reserve the right to cancel or interrupt the "Duel Waterline" event and will not issue any refunds. Registration for the competition implies full and unconditional acceptance of these regulations. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the competitor's disqualification by the organizers.

WARNING: In the event of *force majeure* or bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to reschedule the events. No refunds will be issued for athletes who fail to be at the rescheduled event times.

As an athlete participating in the Outdoormix Festival, you represent your sport and the event. Therefore, you are asked to respect the staff, the public, other participants, as well as the equipment, facilities, and cleanliness of the site. Failure to comply with these rules of conduct may result in sanctions being applied by the Race Steward (assistance with cleaning or repairs, distribution of promotional items, or even criminal penalties if the Race Steward deems the offense warrants referral to the appropriate authorities).

For the purchasers of the "RIDE & PARTY PASS", the concert evenings are included in the pass; in the event of concert cancellations, no refunds will be issued.

8. COMPLAINTS

Complaints regarding the conduct of the competition or the behavior of other competitors must be submitted in writing and signed by the rider within 60 minutes after the end of the competition. Complaints regarding the results must be filed within 30 minutes after the display of the results.

9. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

In order to protect the environment and the natural areas where the event is held, it is



strictly forbidden to leave any waste (paper, packaging, plastic, etc.) on the site. Bins will be available and must be used by all participants.

10. IMAGE REPRODUCTION RIGHTS

By participating in the “DUEL WATERLINE” competition during the 12th edition of the Outdoormix Festival, - which will be held from May 22 to 25, 2026 - each participant expressly authorizes the organizer to use or reproduce their name, image, voice and sporting performance within the framework of this event.
