1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Wingfoil competitions are organized as part of the Outdoormix Festival from Friday, May 22nd to Monday, May 25th, 2026. This event is co-organized by the non-profit association WeAreHautesAlpes, represented by Mr. Brice Clovis, President, and the non-profit association Club Nautique Alpin de Serre-ponçon, represented by Mr. Philippe D'ALESSANDRI.

Check-in and registration close 2 hours before each competition.

2. COMPETITIONS & TRAINING

The organizers, race officials, and judges may hold a meeting with the athletes to communicate the rules and race instructions, or to share any other information. The number of participants is limited to 80 runners across all events.

2.1. South championships

The regatta will be held by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. The Notice of Race will be issued at least one month before the start of the competition. The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at the latest upon registration.

The competition will consist of several races on a closed course.

The specific events will be defined in the SI.

2.2. Program

3. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION & EQUIPMENT

The “WINGFOIL” competitions are open to all competitors aged 12 and over, who hold either a current FFV (French Sailing Federation) license (marked "competition") or a medical certificate (dated less than 3 months prior to the competition date) stating that there are no contraindications to participating in competitive sailing. If a competitor registers with a medical certificate, they will need to pay an additional €55 on the day of the event to obtain a temporary FFVoile competition license valid for 4 days, or opt for an annual license — €72 for adults or €33 for juniors.

Underaged competitors must present parental authorization to participate in the competition. All registrations for the “WINGFOIL” event are individual, non-transferable, and non-refundable. No refunds, full or partial, will be issued by the organizers.

To take part in the competitions, each competitor must have paid the registration fee for the event (on the website www.outdoormixfestival.com or at the event reception desk), have provided the necessary documents and be equipped with the required equipment.

Before the competition, each competitor must check-in at the event reception desk and collect their race number. A €20 deposit will be required from each participant. Please note that any participant who has not collected their race number will not be allowed to participate in the events.

Age categories:

- U15 category : participant must be 12 to 14 years old
- U19 category : participants must be 15 to 18 years old
- U35 category : participants must be 19 to 34 years old
- Master category : participants must be 35 years old or older

Racers are divided into categories according to their age as of December 31st of the year in question.

This competition will feature four categories: U15 (12-14 years old), U19 (15-18 years old), U35 (19-34 years old), and Master (35 years and older).

The maximum number of participants is 80, across all categories.

Mandatory equipment:

- Foil and wing board in good working order;
- Wingfoil wing;
- Helmet compliant with EN 1385;
- Personal buoyancy aids (PBA - 30 kg and under: 100N compliant with EN 12402-4 / Over 30 kg: 50N compliant with EN 12402-5);
- Full-length, long-legged wetsuit with a minimum thickness of 2 mm, worn in its entirety.



4. INSURANCE & LIABILITY

Medical and hospitalization expenses remain the responsibility of the participants (personal insurance). The organizers decline all responsibility in case of loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or equipment and cannot be held liable under any circumstances. In the event of a participant withdrawing from the race, no refund will be issued.

Each sailor must be holding a French Sailing Federation (FFVoile) Club License:

- Either a valid FFVoile Club License with the "competition" designation, accompanied by a medical certificate stating no contraindication to competitive sailing.
- Or an FFVoile Club License with the "membership" or "participant" designation, accompanied by a medical certificate stating no contraindication to competitive sailing, dated within the last year.

5. RESULTS & PODIUMS

Following the two rounds of the obstacle course, a podium ceremony will be held on Sunday, May 24th. For freestyle, the podium ceremony will take place on Monday, June 9th. The podium will be determined by the judges based on the participants' results. Prizes, including prize money for the male and female winners, and other prizes will be awarded according to the overall ranking, as follows:

- Category U15 Girls
- Category U15 Boys
- Category U19 Girls
- Category U19 Boys
- Women scratch
- Men scratch
- Freestyle women scratch
- Freestyle men scratch

The organizer reserves the right to distribute the prizes as they see fit. All competitors must be present at the awards ceremony. Prizes cannot be given to a third party and will not be mailed, with the exception of prize money, which can be transferred after the event.

For the U15 and Freestyle categories, a podium will be set up once five participants are registered and present.

For the U19 and Scratch categories, a podium will be set up once five participants are registered and present.



6. CANCELLATION AND COMMITMENT

The organizers reserve the right to modify these regulations at any time to ensure the safety and well-being of participants. In the event of *force majeure*, the organizers reserve the right to cancel or interrupt the "Wingfoil" events and will not issue any refunds. Registration for the competition implies full and unconditional acceptance of these regulations. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the competitor's disqualification by the organizers.

WARNING: In the event of *force majeure* or bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to reschedule the events. No refunds will be issued for athletes who fail to be at the rescheduled event times.

As an athlete participating in the Outdoormix Festival, you represent your sport and the event. Therefore, you are asked to respect the staff, the public, other participants, as well as the equipment, facilities, and cleanliness of the site. Failure to comply with these rules of conduct may result in sanctions being applied by the Race Steward (assistance with cleaning or repairs, distribution of promotional items, or even criminal penalties if the Race Steward deems the offense warrants referral to the appropriate authorities).

For the purchasers of the "RIDE & PARTY PASS", the concert evenings are included in the pass; in the event of concert cancellations, no refunds will be issued.

7. COMPLAINTS

The time limit for filling a complaint will be shared by the competition manager during the meeting before the competition.

8. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

In order to protect the environment and the natural areas where the event is held, it is strictly forbidden to leave any waste (paper, packaging, plastic, etc.) on the site. Bins will be available and must be used by all participants.

9. IMAGE REPRODUCTION RIGHTS

By participating in the "WINGFOIL" competition during the 12th edition of the Outdoormix Festival, - which will be held from May 22 to 25, 2026 - each participant expressly authorizes the organizer to use or reproduce their name, image, voice and sporting performance within the framework of this event.
