



SPORTS REGULATION 2024

BOULDERING CONTEST

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1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Bouldering Contest is organized as part of the Outdoormix Festival, taking place from Friday May 17 to Monday May 20, 2024. This event is co-organized by the association of law 1901 WeAreHautesAlpes, represented by Mr. Brice Clovis, as co-president, and the association of law 1901 Club Alpin Français d'Embrun, represented by Mr. PONCHON Guillaume.

Check-in and registration close 2 hours before each competition.

2. COMPETITION

2.1 Program

The climbing contest will take place from Friday May 17 to Monday May 20, 2024:

2.2 Qualifications

Qualification phases are self-judged. Key boulders may be monitored. Competitors will have to fill results forms online and must hand them in at the end of the qualifications. Boulders sent after this time will not be counted.



Each competitor will fill in his or her own results on an online form (the link will be given on the day of the competition). 6 women and 6 men will be selected for the U16/16+ global finals.

The qualification phase merges into the final phase for competitors in the U12 and U14 categories. U12 competitors will climb on Junior boulders and U14 competitors on Senior boulders.

U16 competitors and 16+ competitors compete in the same category, a single podium will be held for both U16 competitors and 16+ competitors.

2.3 Ranking

Competitors in the U12 category must send as many boulders as possible among 16 boulders.

Competitors in the U14 and U16/16+ categories compete on the same boulders. They must send as much boulders as possible among the 20 qualifying boulders. The first 6 men and the first 6 women in the U16/16+ category qualify for the final.

Each boulder has an initial value of 1,000 points. This value is divided by the number of people who sent it. Thus, a boulder completed 10 times will earn 100 points for each competitor who sent it.

2.4 Finals

Only the U16/16+ category has a finals phase:

- Three boulders will be opened to the 6 women and 6 men finalists.

The finalists try each boulder in turn:

- One try per turn
- The number of attempts is limited to three per person.
- Competitors start in reverse order of qualification ranking (6th, 5th, 4th, 3rd, 2nd and 1st).

The finalists will be selected by the number of boulders sent, then the number of trials, then the number of zones and the number of trials per zone.

For U12 and U14 categories, the qualification phase merges into the final phase. Participants will be ranked by the number of boulders sent, then by the number of tries, then by the number of zones and finally by the number of tries per zone.

3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS AND EQUIPMENT

3.1 Conditions of participation

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The bouldering contest is open to all competitors having an FFCAM license or a medical certificate for competitive climbing issued less than three years before the date of the competition. For all registrations with a medical certificate, an additional fee will be charged for the purchase of a daily FFCAM license at the event reception desk. For non-licences, the purchase of daily FFCAM licenses will allow access to the competition for a maximum of 3 days out of the 4 days of the festival.

Registration for the bouldering contest is individual, nominative and non-transferable. No total or partial reimbursement will be made by the organization.

To be allowed to compete, each competitor must have paid the registration fee for the event (on the website www.outdoormixfestival.com or at the event reception desk), have provided the necessary documents and be equipped with the required material. **Minors are required to provide, in addition to other documents, parental authorization for the climbing contest.**

Before the beginning of the contest, each competitor must check in at the event village reception desk. Please note that participants who fail to check-in will not be allowed to take part in the event.

The maximum number of participants is 90 for the U14 and U16/16+ categories. The maximum number for the U12 category is 30.

3.2 Equipment

Climbing shoes are mandatory. Liquid or powdered chalk is allowed.

4. INSURANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY

The organization takes out insurance covering its own civil accountability as organizer, those of its employees and those of people volunteering to help organize the event. Individual accident insurance is also taken out to cover body injuries for participants themselves, as well as accidents caused to third parties.

Participants are responsible for their own medical and hospitalization expenses (personal insurance). The organization declines all responsibility for any loss, theft or damage to material or individual equipment, and cannot be held accountable under any circumstances. No reimbursement will be made if a participant withdraws during the race.

5. RANKINGS, PODIUMS & PRIZES

At the end of the event, a podium will reward the top three competitors. The various rankings, based on competitors' gender and age, will be displayed in front of the event village reception area. Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors in each category and gender, based on the overall rankings:

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- U12 categories: prizes
- U14 categories: prizes
- U16/16+: prize money + prizes

The organizer reserves the right to distribute the prize money as he sees fit.

Prizewinners must attend the prize-giving ceremony. Prizes will not be given to a third party and will not be sent later, with the exception of prize money, for which a transfer may be made after the event.

6. CANCELLATION & COMMITMENT

The organization reserves the right to modify the present rules and/or the various boulders at any time, in order to ensure the interest and safety of the participants. In the event of force majeure, the organization reserves the right to cancel or interrupt the bouldering contest, and will not be entitled to any reimbursement. Registration for the competition implies full acceptance of the present rules. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the withdrawal of the competitor's number.

PLEASE NOTE: In the event of force majeure or bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to reschedule events. No reimbursement will be made in the event of a competitor's non-attendance at the modified event times.

As a competitor in the Outdoormix Festival, you represent your sport and the event. You are therefore expected to respect the staff, the public and other participants, as well as the equipment, structures and cleanliness of the site. In the event of failure to comply with these rules of good manners, sanctions may be applied by the staff and/or judges (help with cleaning or repairs, distribution of goodies, or even criminal sanctions if the organization deems that the fault requires police intervention).

For "FULL PASS" purchases, concert evenings are included in the pass. In the event of concert cancellation, no reimbursement will be made.

7. COMPLAINTS

Complaints concerning the conduct of the event or the behavior of other competitors must be submitted in writing and signed by the athlete within 60 minutes of the facts being established. Complaints concerning the ranking must be submitted within 30 minutes of the results being announced and displayed.



8. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

In order to respect the environment and the natural spaces crossed, it is strictly forbidden to leave garbage (paper, packaging, plastic, etc.) on site. Garbage cans will be available and must be used by competitors.

9. IMAGE & RIGHTS OF USE

By participating in the "BOULDERING CONTEST" during the 10th edition of the Outdoormix Festival taking place from May 17 to 20, 2024, each participant expressly authorizes the organizer to use or reproduce their name, image, voice and sporting performance in connection with this event.
