OUTDOORMIX FESTIVAL



1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Trickline contest is organized as part of the Outdoormix Festival, taking place in Embrun from Friday May 17 to Monday May 20, 2024. This event is organized by the non-profit organization We Are Hautes-Alpes, represented by Mr. Clovis BRICE, as co-president.

Check-in and registration close 2 hours before each competition.

2. COMPETITION

The "Trickline" event will take place from Friday, May 17 to Monday, May 20, 2024 at the Outdoormix Festival village. Participants will compete over two competition times: the qualifications and the finals. During qualifications, participants compete in rounds of 1 vs 1, they each have a time limit of 1 minute and 30 seconds to perform as many tricks and combos as possible to score points. The stopwatch pauses every time the athletes jump off the slackline and put a foot on the ground. At the end of each qualifying round, the jury names a winner who qualifies for the final. The same head-to-head principle will be applied in the final, with a time limit of 2 minutes per competitor.

2.1 Program

3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS AND EQUIPMENT

The Trickline event is open to all competitors holding an FFCAM license or a medical certificate for **the practice of slackline in competition** issued less than 3 years before Monday May 20, 2024 or a travel/sport international insurance. Registration for the "Trickline" event is individual, nominative and non-transferable. In order to take the start, each competitor must have provided the necessary documents and be equipped with the required material. Slippers are mandatory to take part in the Trickline Contest.

4. STOPWATCH

The timer starts either on the first bounce for a dynamic start, or on the first figure for a static start, or on the standing position for a “chongo” or “drop-knee” start.

Each competitor is allowed to 1 minute and 30 seconds during the qualifying rounds, and 2 minutes in the finals.

In order to alternate between the 2 competitors, the stopwatch will stop as soon as the athlete has come out of the line (fall or voluntary exit). If a trickliner is still doing a combo when time stops, the athlete may continue their combo for a **maximum of 15 seconds**. Once the combo has been completed or the 15 seconds have passed, the judges will stop taking the tricks into account when grading.

5. GRADING SYSTEM

The judges grade each competitor as follows:

"Difficulty score" = overall difficulty of the run + bonus combos - dabs malus;

"Execution score" = Total "difficulty score" + diversity + overall style of the run;

"Final grade" = Total "execution grade" + amplitude of the run.

The maximum score for a run is 40 points.

6. INSURANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY

The organization takes out insurance covering its own civil accountability as organizer, those of its employees and those of people volunteering to help organize the event. Individual accident insurance is also taken out to cover body injuries for participants themselves, as well as accidents caused to third parties.

Participants are responsible for their own medical and hospitalization expenses (personal insurance). The organization declines all responsibility for any loss, theft or damage to material or individual equipment, and cannot be held accountable under any circumstances. No reimbursement will be made if a participant withdraws during the race.

7. RANKINGS, PODIUMS AND PRIZES

At the end of the event, a podium will reward the top three finishers. Rankings by gender and age will be posted in front of the event village reception area. A €1,500 Prize Money, will be awarded to the top three participants in the overall rankings. The organizer reserves the right to distribute the prize money as he sees fit. **Competitors must be present at the prize-giving ceremony.**

8. CANCELLATION AND COMMITMENT

The organization reserves the right to modify the present rules at any time, in order to ensure the interest and safety of the participants. In the event of force majeure, the organization reserves the right to cancel or interrupt the trickline contest. Registration for the competition implies full acceptance of the present rules. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the withdrawal of the competitor's number.

PLEASE NOTE: In the event of force majeure or bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to reschedule events.

As a competitor in the Outdoormix Festival, you represent your sport and the event. You are therefore expected to respect the staff, the public and other participants, as well as the equipment, structures and cleanliness of the site. In the event of failure to comply with these rules of good manners, sanctions may be applied by the staff and/or judges (help with cleaning or repairs, distribution of goodies, or even criminal sanctions if the organization deems that the fault requires police intervention).

9. COMPLAINTS

Complaints concerning the conduct of the event or the behavior of other competitors must be submitted in writing and signed by the athlete within 60 minutes of the facts being established. Complaints concerning the ranking must be submitted within 30 minutes of the results being announced and displayed.

10. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

In order to respect the environment and the natural spaces crossed, it is strictly forbidden to leave garbage (paper, packaging, plastic, etc.) on site. Garbage cans will be available and must be used by competitors.

11. IMAGE AND RIGHTS OF USE

By participating in the "TRICKLINE CONTEST" during the 10th edition of the Outdoormix Festival taking place from May 17 to 20, 2024, each participant expressly authorizes the organizer to use or reproduce their name, image, voice and sporting performance in connection with this event.
