# OUTDOORMIX FESTIVAL



## 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Outdoormix Festival organizes the Duel Waterline as part of the 10th edition of the festival, taking place in Embrun from Friday, May 17 to Monday, May 20, 2024. This event is co-organized by the association of law 1901 We Are Hautes-Alpes, represented by Mr. BRICE Clovis, as co-president, and the association of law 1901 ALPLINE, represented by Mr. LAXENAIRE Adrien.

**Check-in and registration close 2 hours before each competition.**

## 2. COMPETITION

The "WATERLINE SPEED WATER CHALLENGE" event will take place on Saturday May 18 and Sunday May 19, 2024 at the Outdoormix Festival village. Contestants compete in a Speed Duel walking across water on two lines of equal distance. There are two rounds of competition: the qualifying round and the final. In the qualifying round, competitors must walk the 30m of slackline side by side in the shortest time possible. The winner of each duel is the first to reach the end of the course. If they both fall, the winner is the one who went the furthest on the slackline.

At the end of each qualifying duel, the winners enter new duel phases. Qualifying rounds come to an end when only 8 participants remain and qualify for the finals.

The same speed duel principle will be applied in the finals.

## 3. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

The Waterline Duel is open to all competitors aged 16 and over.

Registration for the "Duel Waterline" event is individual, nominative and non-transferable.

To be allowed to take the start, each competitor must have registered at the event reception desk and be equipped with the required equipment. **Minors are required to provide parental authorization for the Duel Waterline.**

To reduce the risk of eardrums being pierced by falling flat on the water, we advise to wear earplugs or a choker over the ears.

## **4. ACCESS TO FACILITIES**

- All athletes must be registered to enter the competition.
- All athletes must respect the facilities, other athletes and the staff.
- It is STRICTLY forbidden for two or more people to walk on a Slackline/Waterline at the same time.
- All athletes are responsible for themselves and must know their skills and limits.
- Minors must show parental authorization each time they climb on a slackline/waterline.
- Athletes are advised not to leave their personal belongings unattended. The organization cannot be held responsible for the loss of personal belongings in the event of negligence on the part of users.
- The organization cannot be held responsible for any damage caused by misuse of the equipment provided.
- Athletes can be held accountable of any damage they may cause to equipment
- Failure to comply with these rules may result in being banned to use the equipment.
- Any person whose behavior disturbs public order, disrupts the organization of the various activities, or violates public decency, hygiene or safety, may be expelled immediately from the facility by the organizer and/or the competent authority.

## **5. INSURANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY**

The organization takes out insurance covering its own civil accountability as organizer, those of its employees and those of people volunteering to help organize the event. Individual accident insurance is also taken out to cover body injuries for participants themselves, as well as accidents caused to third parties.

Participants are responsible for their own medical and hospitalization expenses (personal insurance). The organization declines all responsibility for any loss, theft or damage to material or individual equipment, and cannot be held accountable under any circumstances.

## **6. RANKINGS AND PODIUMS**

At the end of the event, a podium will reward the top three athletes. Rankings by gender and age will be displayed in front of the event village reception desk. Prizes will be awarded to the top three participants in the overall ranking. The organizer reserves the right to distribute prizes as he sees fit. Competitors must be present at the prize-giving ceremony. Prizes may only be given to a third party and will not be sent by post.

## **7. CANCELLATION AND COMMITMENT**

The organization reserves the right to modify the present rules at any time, in order to ensure the interest and safety of the participants. In the event of force majeure, the organization reserves the right to cancel or interrupt the duel waterline. Registration for the competition implies full acceptance of the present rules. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the withdrawal of



the competitor's number.

**PLEASE NOTE:** In the event of force majeure or bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to reschedule events.

As a competitor in the Outdoormix Festival, you represent your sport and the event. You are therefore expected to respect the staff, the public and other participants, as well as the equipment, structures and cleanliness of the site. In the event of failure to comply with these rules of good manners, sanctions may be applied by the staff and/or judges (help with cleaning or repairs, distribution of goodies, or even criminal sanctions if the organization deems that the fault requires police intervention).

## **8. COMPLAINTS**

Complaints concerning the conduct of the event or the behavior of other competitors must be submitted in writing and signed by the athlete within 60 minutes of the facts being established. Complaints concerning the ranking must be submitted within 30 minutes of the results being announced and displayed.

## **9. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT**

In order to respect the environment and the natural spaces crossed, it is strictly forbidden to leave garbage (paper, packaging, plastic, etc.) on site. Garbage cans will be available and must be used by competitors.

## **10. IMAGE AND RIGHTS OF USE**

By participating in the "DUEL WATERLINE" during the 10th edition of the Outdoormix Festival taking place from May 17 to 20, 2024, each participant expressly authorizes the organizer to use or reproduce their name, image, voice and sporting performance in connection with this event.
