1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The "WINGFOIL" events are organized as part of the 2024 edition of the Outdoormix Festival, which will take place from Friday May 17 to Monday May 20, 2024.

The competition is co-organized by the association of law 1901 WeAreHautesAlpes, represented by Mr. Clovis BRICE as co-president, and the association of law 1901 Club Nautique Alpin Serre Ponçon, represented by Mr. Christian GLEVAR as president.

Check-in and registration close 2 hours before each competition.

2. COMPETITION

The organizers, race marshals and judges may decide to organize a meeting with the athletes to pass on race regulations and instructions, or to pass on any other information.

The number of participants is limited to 60 riders in total.

2.1 Ligue Wing Tour Sud 2024 Championships

The "Wingfoil" Wing Tour Région Sud 2024 event is a grade 5A competition taking place from Saturday, May 18 to Monday, May 20, 2024.

The regatta will be judged by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. The Notice of Race will be published at least one month before the start of the competition. The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at the time of registration at the latest.

The competition will take the form of several rounds on a closed course:

- Individual slalom
- Freestyle

3. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS AND EQUIPMENT

3.1 Conditions of Participation

The "WINGFOIL" event is open to all competitors aged 12 and over, holding either a current FFV license (bearing the word "competition"), or a medical certificate (less than 3 years old on competition day) enabling the contestant to practice wingfoil in competition. If an athlete registers with a medical certificate, they will be required to pay an additional fee of €34 on the day of the event corresponding to the purchase of a 4-day FFV competition license.

Minors must also present parental authorization to take part in the competition.

Registration for the "WINGFOIL" event is individual, nominative and non-transferable. No total or partial reimbursement will be made by the organization. In order to participate, each competitor must have paid the registration fee for the event (on the website www.outdoormixfestival.com or at the event reception desk), have provided the necessary documents and be equipped with the required material.

Before setting off on the races, each competitor must check-in and collect his or her number from the event village reception desk. A deposit of €15 will be required from each participant regarding the race number they will receive. Please note that participants who have not collected their number will not be able to take part in the events.

For contestants in the U15 category, the minimum age required is 12, for those in the U19 category (which is a step towards selection for the French championships) the minimum age is 15, for the U35 competition the minimum age is 19 and for the Master competition it is 35. Riders are divided into categories according to their age on December 31st, 2024.

Four categories will be represented in this competition: U15 (12-14 year-olds), U19 (15-18 year-olds), U35 (19-34 year-olds) and Master (35 year-olds and over).

The maximum number of participants is 60 in total.

^{*}Starting time is scheduled at 12 a.m., it may be postponed to the afternoon depending on weather conditions.



3.2 Equipment

- Foil and wing board in good sailing condition;
- Wing;
- Helmet EN 1385;
- Personal buoyancy equipment (PFD 30 kg and under: 100N / Over 30 kg: 50N), impact vest or jacket;
- Long-leg wetsuit with a minimum thickness of 2 mm worn in its entirety.

4. INSURANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY

The organization takes out insurance covering its own civil accountability as organizer, those of its employees and those of people volunteering to help organize the event. Individual accident insurance is also taken out to cover body injuries for participants themselves, as well as accidents caused to third parties.

Participants are responsible for their own medical and hospitalization expenses (personal insurance). The organization declines all responsibility for any loss, theft or damage to material or individual equipment, and cannot be held accountable under any circumstances. No reimbursement will be made if a participant withdraws during the race.

5. RANKINGS, PODIUM AND PRIZES

At the end of the 2 rounds of the slalom, a podium will be held on Sunday, May 19. The freestyle podium will be held on Monday, May 20. The podium will be determined by the judges on the basis of the participants' results. Rewards, including Prize Money for the winner, and prizes will be awarded according to the overall ranking. The organizer reserves the right to allocate prizes as he sees fit. All competitors must attend the prize-giving ceremony. Prizes will not be given to third parties and will not be sent by post, except for prize money, for which a transfer may be made after the event.

6. CANCELLATION AND COMMITMENT

The organizers reserve the right to modify these rules and/or the various routes at any time, in the interest of participants' safety. In case of force majeure or for any other reason (in particular to ensure the safety of the competition), the organizers reserve the right to cancel or interrupt the "WING TOUR RÉGION SUD" event, and will not be entitled to any refund. Registration for the competition implies full acceptance of the present rules. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the withdrawal of the competitor's number.

The cancellation of a round, event or part of an event is the responsibility of the race director. If the competition is paused in the middle of the qualifying round, it may be postponed to a later time if possible, or cancelled. In the latter case, all riders qualify for the following phases. If the final phases are cancelled, the ranking will be that of the qualifying phases.



PLEASE NOTE: In the event of force majeure or bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to reschedule events. No reimbursement will be made in the event of a participant's non-attendance at the modified event times.

As a competitor in the Outdoormix Festival, you represent your sport and the event. You are therefore expected to respect the staff, the public and other participants, as well as the equipment, structures and cleanliness of the site. In the event of failure to comply with these rules of good manners, sanctions may be applied by the staff and/or judges (help with cleaning or repairs, distribution of goodies, or even criminal sanctions if the organization deems that the fault requires referral to the appropriate authorities).

For "FULL PASS" purchases, concert evenings are included in the pass. In the event of concert cancellation, no reimbursement will be made.

7. COMPLAINTS

Complaints concerning the conduct of the event or the behavior of other competitors must be submitted in writing and signed by the athlete within 60 minutes of the facts being established. Complaints concerning the ranking must be submitted within 30 minutes of the results being announced and displayed.

8. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

In order to respect the environment and the natural spaces crossed, it is strictly forbidden to leave garbage (paper, packaging, plastic, etc.) on site. Garbage cans will be available and must be used by competitors.

9. IMAGE AND RIGHTS OF USE

By participating in the "WING TOUR SUD" during the 10th edition of the Outdoormix Festival taking place from May 17 to 20, 2024, each participant expressly authorizes the organizer to use or reproduce their name, image, voice and sporting performance in connection with this event
